

C. Registration

Logistics

Elected officers of each lodge, chapter, and court and lodge instructors are required to register at a fee of \$80.00 per officer (whether in attendance or not). As such, each lodge must remit payment of \$480 for registration. The same fee (\$80.00) applies to other members who wish to attend. The deadline to receive lodge registrations is Friday, August 5, 2022. Late and on-site registrations are \$90 and \$100, respectively.

Registration is all-inclusive (i.e., food, and Friday and Saturday night events), except for those who register for the golf tournament. The cost of registering for the golf tournament is forthcoming.

Life Members

Although Grand Lodge life members are exempt from registration fees, written notification must be received by the Office of the Grand Secretary by August 5, 2022. However, if a life member serves as one of the elected lodge officers, the office must still pay the registration fee, and another member may attend using said registration.






