# The Rev. Dr. James English Brant Student-Aid Award Applications

#### I. Announcement and Guidelines

The Committee on Education of the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge Most Ancient and Honorable Fraternity Free and Accepted Masons of Florida, Belize, Central America & Jurisdiction, Inc. takes pride in announcing the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge Foundation Annual C. H. Henry Memorial Scholarship Award. All applicants for this scholarship shall be governed by the following guidelines.

- A. A four-year scholarship award in the amount of \$6,000 may be awarded to graduating high school seniors from Florida, Belize, Central America & Jurisdiction, Inc.
  - 1. The amount of \$6,000.00 may be awarded to students who attend a four-year College or University for 4 years in the major of his/her choice. The student must maintain 3.0 G.P.A. or higher for the duration of the award.
  - 2. The \$6,000.00 will be paid at a rate of \$1,500.00 a year for four years
  - 3. If a student is enrolled in a 6-year Program, the scholarship award will be \$6,000.00, payable at \$1,000.00 a year for 6 years. The student must maintain 3.0 G.P.A. or higher for the duration of the award.
- B. The recipient of the scholarship shall name as his/her choice, any accredited College or University within the State of Florida.

#### II. Qualifications for Receiving Scholarship or Student-Aid Awards

- A. All applicants for the scholarship award must be the son, daughter, brother, sister, grandchild, niece, nephew or the child of a legal guardian of the member of any of the Departments of our Prince Hall Families, or a member of a youth group of a Concordant or Appendant Body working under the protection of the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge Most Ancient and Honorable Fraternity Free and Accepted Masons of Florida, Belize, Central America & Jurisdiction, Inc.
- B. Applicants must be an active member of a youth group for 4 years; High School Students (9-12) with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher or Trade/Vocational School G.P.A. of 2.0 or higher.

#### III. Procedure for Applying for Scholarships

#### A. Applicants should:

- 1. Obtain a blank application from the Lodge or Masonic Body that will make a recommendation to the Education Committee on their behalf.
- 2. Submit the name and number of the Masonic Lodge, Concordant or Appendant Body, working under the protection of the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge and Jurisdiction, to show parent, guardian or Youth Group Affiliation.
- 3. Submit his or her achievement test scores on the approved standardized test for high school seniors; S.A.T. or A.C.T.
- 4. Submit a *type-written* essay or autobiography between 250 and 500 words, explaining his/her ambitions, achievements, occupational goals and extra-curricular participation etc.. Please be specific. Attach a current photograph to the application.
- 5. Submit at least <u>Three</u> Character references, including one from a school, a church, and a community leader.
- 6. Obtain an official transcript, sealed from his/her school for grades nine (9) through the first semester of their senior year. Submit the transcript along with the application.
- 7. All applications must be reviewed and signed by the applicant, Worshipful Master, District Deputy (Blue Lodge) and if applicable, the Department Head and post marked by February 28th. NO EXCEPTIONS!

#### **B.** The Return of Completed Applications

- The application, with all supporting documents, must be mailed by the Worshipful Master, District Deputy or Department Head, return receipt request and received by the Chairman of the Committee on Education by Midnight of February 28<sup>th</sup>.

#### IV. Selection of Scholarship Recipients

- a. The Committee on Education shall judge the information received based on the above criteria to determine the recipients of the scholarships.
- b. The decision of the Committee on Education will make their recommendations to the Junior Grand Warden for approval of the Grand Master

#### V. Establishment of Residence

Each Scholarship recipient, once he/she has established their place of residency, shall annually send their address and telephone or cell phone number, with area code to the Chairman of Education within a period of 2 weeks, following their enrollment in school

#### VI. Change of School

Should the scholarship recipient desire to change schools, it will be his/her responsibility to send to the Committee on Education the name and address of the new school, along with proof of acceptance by the new school according to the established guidelines

#### VII. Distribution of Guidelines

The Grand Lodge will disperse scholarship funds after the second Friday in September (drop and add period for most schools). As such, validated proof from the school can be submitted by the student, demonstrating that he or she is actually enrolled in the minimum number of hours (12) after the drop and add period ends. All information regarding scholarships and student aid, along with an application for, shall be sent to the Worshipful Master, Deputies, Zone Directors, Department Heads and Committee on Education members, along with the Grand Master's Annual Proclamation. Any of the aforementioned not receiving scholarship information should contact the Chairman of the Committee on Education in order to receive a copy of the same.

#### VIII. Validation of Acceptance and Enrollment in School

The student must validate his acceptance and enrollment in school with the Committee on Education by way of a letter from the Registrar's Office of the institution he/she anticipates attending, including their student ID and social security number. At the end of each semester, the student must send to the Committee Chairman a report of the subjects taken and the grades earned (a current official transcript).

#### X. Scholarship Renewal

- A. Each Scholarship recipient must apply annually using the Scholarship Renewal Form on or before July 1st.
- B. The form should be obtained from the Chairman of the Committee on Education at the close of the Spring Semester of each year.
- C. To be eligible for renewal of Scholarship Awards, all receipts must maintain a grade point average of: Junior College/University/College 3.0 or higher; Trade/Vocational School a sealed letter of satisfactory performance from the Trade/Vocational School that the applicant attends.

#### XI. The Rev. Dr. James English Brant Student-Aid Award

- A. The Rev. Dr. James English Brant Student-Aid Award is a one-time donation of \$600.00. The award is made payable to the Student, if currently enrolled in college with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher, and he/she can prove a hardship and need for emergency financial assistance.
- B. All applicants for Student-Aid must meet the qualification stated in section III above.
- C. Student-Aid awards are limited to Sophomores and above.

#### PRE-RECORDED INTERVIEWS

Candidates are asking for a \$6000 scholarship over a period of four or six years). Moving away from live interviews, the purpose of the one-way video interview is to confirm the candidate meets the basic requirements for the scholarship. If needed, a follow-up interview may be required. Here are some helpful tips:

#### Read and follow the instructions very carefully

You will be more successful in the interview and you will demonstrate your ability to work carefully and thoroughly by following the directions for the interview very carefully. Skipping this step — or just quickly glancing at the instructions — can automatically disqualify you before the interview even begins. Avoid making assumptions about the process that could be wrong.

#### Ensure the Right Device is Used

Bad recordings influence the outcome of the interview process. Proper lighting, sound, and background say a lot about the candidate.

#### Have your Interview Answers Ready

A positive for a recording is one can redo the video until it is perfected. As the requirements are provided, the recording should be flawless.

#### Practice, Practice, Practice

Choose a quiet spot where, hopefully, you will be the only person visible (and audible). Don't make the mistake of trying to do this interview in a busy place with many distractions around. Keep the interview background as simple as possible, like a blank white wall.

#### Dress the Part

While your interviewer can only see your top half in a video interview, it's a good idea to wear full professional attire from head to toe to avoid any unnecessary embarrassment. Professional attire usually means a suit or blazer, a shirt, dress pants, or a skirt.

#### Look Directly at the Camera

When you are answering a question, look directly at the camera rather than at your computer screen. Imagine that the person who will be viewing this video is right there. Pretend you are talking to that person.

#### Pay Attention to the Clock

Usually, these interviews have a time limit. So, put a clock where you can easily see it, and use the time wisely.

Dr. James English Bryant Student-Aid Award, all of the requirements identified on this checklist must be met and/or submitted to the Education Committee of the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge, Most Ancient and Honorable Fraternity Free and Accepted Masons of Florida, Belize, Central America & Jurisdiction, Inc.

#### APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Are you a graduating high school senior?
- 2. Have you completed the C.H. Henry Memorial Scholarship or the Rev. Dr. James English Bryant Student-Aid Award Application?
- 3. Have you submitted a sealed official transcript from your high school for grades nine (9) thru 1<sup>st</sup> semester of senior year?
- 4. Have you submitted a current 4x6 photograph?
- 5. Have you obtained at least Three Character references: one from a school staff member, one from your church and one from a community leader?
- 6. Have you completed a type-written essay or autobiography of at least 250 words and no more than 500 words explaining ambitions, achievements, occupational goals and extra-curricular participation, etc., (be specific)?
- 7. Have you submitted your achievement test scores on the approved standardized test for high school Seniors? S.A.T. or A.C.T.?
- 8. Have you signed the application?
- 9. Submit the completed package to the Masonic Lodge from which you received the application.

#### MASONIC BODY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Masonic organization will complete the section identifying the lodge or organization submitting the application.
- 2. The Worshipful Master or presiding office will review the application package for completeness and sign application.
- 3. The District Deputy Grand Master will review the application package for completeness and sign application.
- 4. The District Deputy Grand Master will submit the application package to the Education Committee. The application must be postmarked by February 28 of each year.

# C.B. Nelson-Daniels Scholarship Application

#### Scholarship Overview

The Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge of Florida and Jerusalem Grand Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, in collaboration with the C.B. Nelson-Daniels Trust, are proud to offer financial assistance for college to two outstanding students. Two scholars—one from the Fred M. Moore, Jr. Union Grand Council, Order of the Knights of Pythagoras (KOP) and one from the Dr. Tracy A. Thomas Star Lights Youth Council (Star Lights)—will be selected to receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$3,500 for the 2021-2022 academic year. Monies shall be forwarded to the recipient's institution of choice to pay for verifiable costs associated with customary tuition and fees.

#### Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the C.B Nelson-Daniels scholarship, applicants must:

- 1. Graduate from high school during the 2020-2021 academic year.
- 2. Enroll in college courses during the 2021-2022 academic year.
- 3. Hold membership in the KOP or Star Lights Youth Council during the 2020-2021 academic year.
- 4. Possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- 5. Demonstrate financial need, using the requisite platform below.

#### How to Apply

Applicants must complete the following:

- 1. Submit a copy of your current transcript (official or unofficial), including Spring 2020 grades. Your cumulative grade point average should be included.
- 2. Forward a copy of your resume.
- 3. Provide three letters of recommendation, one of which must be a member in good standing of the Most Worshipful Union Grand Lodge of Florida (for KOP members) or Jerusalem Grand Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star (for Star Lights).
- 4. Record a two-minute video and expound on the following:
  - a. The Jurisdiction of Florida believes that we are stronger when we thrive together through exercising empathy, sincerity and respect. During the video, tell us about a time when you exemplified these qualities to facilitate a thriving and inclusive environment in school. Additionally, included in the video should be reasons why the C.B. Nelson-Daniels scholarship is needed to assist with your educational endeavors.
  - b. Ensure that the video begins with your name, institution of choice, and your major (area in which you wish to receive a degree).
